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## SETTING THE STAGE FOR MEMORABLE ROOMS: RONALD REDDING'S NEW "DESIGNER BACKGROUND" COLLECTION

York, PA --- From the masterful and always surprising Ronald Redding, York's VP Design Director, comes his newest collection overflowing with textures and subtle patterns in an unprecedented range of color choices. "The byword here is 'subtlety'," says Redding. "For spaces and tastes which opt for little or no pattern to set the stage for antiques or traditional furnishings, the textures in this collection will fill the bill."

A number of raised screen-printed surfaces include architectural blocks with a raised mesh texture, Ostrich leather with distinctive markings and an industrial metal pattern design edged with trompe l'oeil nail heads – at home in city or contemporary spaces. Other textures merely suggest animal skins, crackle, stripes and herringbone. Extensive colorways run the gamut with some designs available in ten colorways from saturated deep tones to light sand and ivory. Some textures are brushed with metallic inks including bronze, to add richness and depth.

The Ronald Redding brand is available in the luxury wallcovering market through interior designers and trade showrooms.

### Design highlights:

Textural Scroll – large scale, graceful scroll in a wide range of cream, latte, milk and ivory tone-on-tone combinations

Combed Texture – cross combed texture diffuses vertical and horizontal colors resulting in a raised surface, complex color effect. Colors: bronze/gold and neutral combinations from foam to concrete

Animal Skin Scroll – large, over-scale scroll with subtle animal print ground; touched with pearlized metallic ink

Crackle – large and small-scale crackle fuse in a raised screen print in colors ranging from milk to cocoa

Wide Textured stripe – artistic textured crackle and weathered surfaces with soft, adjacent colors in a muted stripe

Raised mesh blocks – raised screen printed blocks of monochromatic tone on tone texture; standard block size resembles construction mesh over stucco

Bamboo Texture – vertical matchstick blinds with the sanded, uneven surface of trompe l'oeil bamboo in cinnamon, vanilla, celedon and sand

Tonal leaves – underwater flora with graceful fronds set against subtle linen texture in navy/navy, cream/sand, flax/slate, mocha, moss and paprika

Moiré stripes – French trompe l’oeil water silk stripes in 10 colors from dark French blue to flax and sand

Ostrich – trompe l’oeil ostrich leather in dramatic dark red and six other neutrals

Vertical strokes – tall, thin, linear stalks of leaves against vertical reedy texture; leaf with stark design in sand

Square Metal – raised screen printed tiny nail heads trim trompe l’oeil textured metal squares in this industrial, loft look

Medley stripe – vertical stripes fuse musical notes with script on a weathered surface

Raised Herringbone – updated interpretation of classic Herringbone printed with a raised surface in 6 colorways

Large Textured Script – snakeskin texture fused with painterly stripes

Waxed texture – subtle, grainy linen background texture in six colors

Snow Leopard – leopard cub faces meld with leopard spots in charcoal; companion design with subtle leopard texture

Torn Paper – hand made crinkle textured paper with natural flecks

Textured Harlequin – stone textured harlequins with antique, old-world surfaces alternating with artistic grouting in 5 colorways
