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YORK'S RONALD REDDING "MASTERS TRADITIONAL HOME"

"Elegance is back!" declares Ronald Redding, York's renowned Director of Design. His stunning new collection is filled with luxurious saturated colors, architectural motifs and superb raised surfaces.

Design highlights:

Floral toss – slender trumpet-shaped flowers on graceful stems with painterly leaves scattered against dramatic backgrounds including midnight black, alabaster, Merlot, butter and creamy white; coordinates with Plaid with Check – large scale woven textile tattersall

Stonewall – raised screen printed trompe l'oeil stone wall with varied size stones, grouting and gently weathered surface in a palette of cement, sand, fieldstone and ivory

Architectural elements – time-honored favorite architectural motifs drawn in a fine hand, sketchbook style including ornamental arched bridge, Regency door, classic French scrollwork with French phrases in script; coordinates with weathered texture architectural Rope Bead Stripe

Mini leaf spot – delicate and tonal maple leaves rendered in light and shadow, create a geometric pattern; coordinates with luxuriously textured tonal silk string stripe

Whitworth Berries – trompe l'oeil strawberries, luscious and ripe on the vine in blossom and bud with foliage set against narrow pinstripes; coordinating border pairs open lattice with berry cascade; coordinating Berry Toss sidewall scatters berry elements at random. Grounds include luminous yellow, crème fresh, vanilla, midnight black and whipped cream

Acanthus – graceful swirls of dense acanthus leaves are dusted with matching sand in a dramatic raised surface against a translucent textured ground in bronze, ivory and earth mineral tones

Shagreen Diamond – with fine crackle glaze ceramic harlequins in light and dark shades of minerals from taupe to peach blush

Hunting toile – based on a classic French period document depicting riders on horseback in typical French countryside; printed to resemble heavy linen texture in black/flax, cherry red/ivory and greige/ivory

Silk damask – delicate and refined floral damask with intricate lacy detail worked with the design

Whitworth Floral – document based, classic floral with delicate dew drop buds, opened blossoms with foliage on graceful rose stem with vintage background colors of French mustard, moss, cream, raisin; coordinates with Trellis formed with delicate textured bamboo shoots

Marble – trompe l'oeil marble texture with delicate veins of color in a fantasy surface

Scroll stripe – broad shadow stripes with delicate scroll tracery; coordinates with Textured Damask

Stucco – textured ground with leafy vine cascade coordinates with tonal trellis pattern
