## CLASSIC AND ELEGANT MENSWEAR LOOKS THEME OF RONALD REDDING'S NEW "MUIR-FIELD" COLLECTION FOR YORK WALLCOVERINGS

York, PA ---Menswear classics – plaids, paisleys, foulards and leather looks—are at the heart of Ronald Redding's new "Muirfield" wallcoverings collection. Redding, York's VP Director of Design and originator of the design division bearing his name, is one of the wallcoverings industry's most respected authorities on color and design.

Embracing a color palette of rich saturated tones, Ron has melded menswear classics with delightful surprises. A herringbone plaid becomes the background to sporting dogs and stylish horse saddles interplay with foulard. The masculine themed collection also includes a golfing scenic, raised surface textures emulating ostrich and elephant skins and model sailboats artfully arranged on a dramatic sidewall.

### Design highlights:

Golf scenic – a perfect fairway and fine putting green find elegant gents of the early 1920's outfitted in dapper caps, knickers and argyles - putting and swinging in a finely engraved pen and ink scenic with matching fabric; coordinates with Woven Plaid Check and Greek Key Stripe

Paisley Floral – oversized feathery paisley; coordinates with paisley spot on pencil slip stripes. Rich color grounds include coffee bean, midnight black, ivory, Oriental red and navy; matching fabric

Pedigree – finely drawn favorite hunting dogs including Springer Spaniels, Labrador Retrievers and Beagles set against houndstooth plaid

Novelty bookcase – trompe l'oeil wood grained book shelves filed with fanciful and classic book titles devoted to the sea with nautical memorabilia; coordinates with raised surface leather texture in masculine colors of buckskin, moss, Merlot, lava and green

Saddles - beautifully detailed horse saddles in a variety of styles on foulard; coordinating Steeplechase Stripe with buckle and braided straps that create narrow and wide stripes

Textured Scroll – graceful swirls of leather texture on Foulard

Elephant skin – raised surface printed texture echoes an uneven and wrinkled pachyderm skin

Leather damask – hand tooled leather and damask textures meld into classic fan shapes and architectural medallions

Ostrich – raised surface Ostrich texture

Ferns – lacy forest ferns finished with matching sand and set against subtle herringbone texture; coordinates with tonal Umbria Stripe herringbone

Whitworth Peony – full blown life-size peonies in with distinctive round buds and abundant foliage set against dramatic grounds of black, Oriental red, midnight black, deep bronze and rich navy blue; coordinates with wide awning tonal stripe
